



Dublin Heights Community Child Care Inc. 2023 Fee Memo

DHCCC has applied and have been approved for the Canada-Wide Early Learning and Child Care (CWELCC) funding for our families with children 6 years and under. Effective January 1st, 2023, there will be a further reduction of 37% to the already reduced 2022 child care fee (bringing the total reduction of fees to 52.75% of the 2022 rates).

Please be advised that there will be a 4.25% increase of fees for our School-age programs to cover annual inflation. There will be a fee for non-instructional days (P.A. Days, March Break, Winter Break and Summer). Although, our fees are calculated at a daily rate, all parents are still required to commit to the whole month. The monthly fee is based on the number of operational days including Statutory holidays within the month. The Centre reserves the right to make changes within the year. A month’s notice will be given prior to any changes.

The 2023 child care fees are as follows (Effective January 1st, 2023):

(For the Toddler, Preschool and Kindergarten programs, the applicable fees for 2023 are noted in column ‘With CWELCC’).

***Kindergarten and School-age holding fee (July and August) for children attending the Dublin Heights CCC Summer Program: \$200.00 (This fee will be used towards your summer fees)**

****Holding fee (all groups) to maintain your spot for September (for families not attending the Summer Program) is \$250.00 or \$125 for one month. (This fee is NON-REFUNDABLE and is used towards your September fee)**

*****All rates are determined upon staffing and extracurricular activities for each group. Kindergarten and School-age children are reminded to bring their own lunches and snacks during non-instructional days.**
